Requirements for New Mexico CCW Class:

- A primary pistol [usually a semi-auto]
 - 125 rounds of FACTORY ammo for primary pistol [no reloads]
 - A secondary pistol if desired [usually a revolver]
 - At least 25 rounds of FACTORY ammo for secondary pistol [no reloads]
 - Any pistol has to be at least .380 cal.
 - A good holster for each pistol
 - Holster must be on the belt, strong side. [right handed on right side, etc.]
 - Holster must cover trigger guard, and be able to draw out of with one hand
 - If semi-auto, at least one spare magazine. Two is better, and with a belt mounted mag holder for them
 - A STRONG belt to hang it all on. Small belts can't handle the weight
 - If qualifying with a revolver, speedloaders are a huge help, but not absolutely necessary
 - Eye and ear protection for the range
 - Pen and paper
 - Lunch/water or we can go out
- That should cover it. The biggest deal right now for all of you should be the ammo.
- Get your ammo now! It's getting hard to find.
